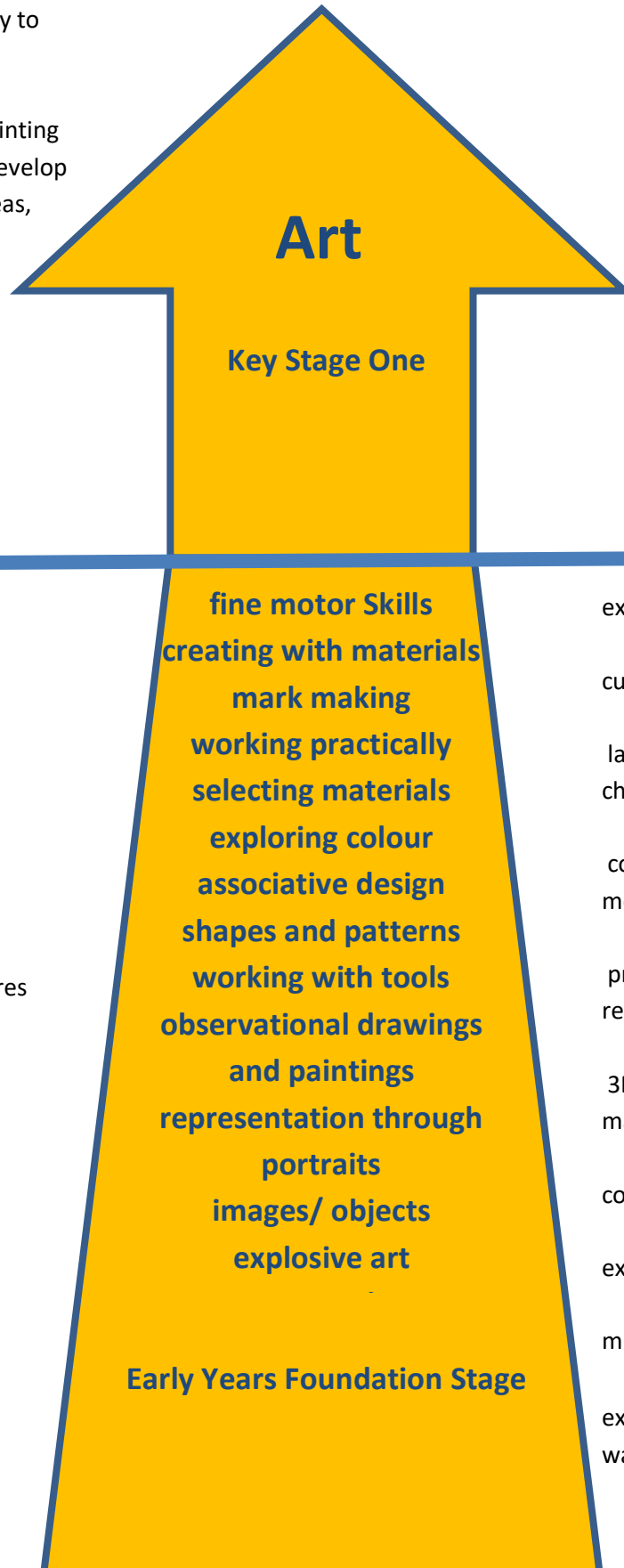




Early Independent Learning Opportunities - a Foundation for the Key Stage One Programmes of Study
