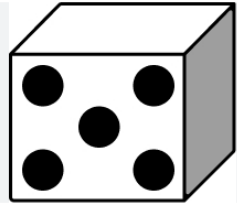


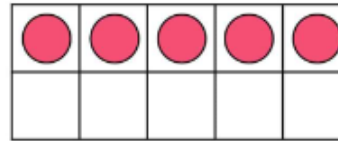

What can this look like?

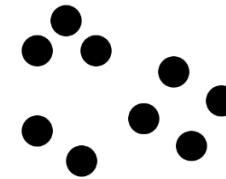

Key Questions to ask at home

What can you see?

Activities to Try

1. your child to say the amount of dots without counting them—you could use any items around your house.
2. To notice objects, patterns and shapes in your local environment—take a walk around your local area, what numbers or shapes can you see?
3. To make observations during walks—Can you draw a map of where you have been and what you have seen?
4. To show quantities to 5 using fingers—say and number and then show the amount using just one hand.
