

## English



Our stimulus for this half term are:

- Inside your outside
- Whiffy Wilson the wolf who wouldn't wash
- My Name is Not Refugee
- Visit to the Winter Gardens

This half term we will be covering a variety of writing genres: poems, instructions, recounts and innovated creative writing. Throughout the term there will be lots of opportunity for speaking and listening along with encouragement for children to use correct punctuation, phonics and spelling skills to further develop the accuracy of their writing. Our stimulus will all be around how to keep our body and mind safe and happy. We will use stories and short video clips to help immerse children into their learning.

## Art



This half term we will be focussing on our drawing skills, developing our use of charcoal, chalk and pastels to add texture and pattern. We will look at a range of different self-portraits as inspiration for creating our own piece.

## Mathematics



We will begin the half term finishing our work on fractions, looking at finding halves and quarters of amounts. We will then use our knowledge of fractions to help us describe position and movement, describing whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns. We will then revisit our knowledge of place value, applying this to numbers to 100. We will finish by telling the time to o'clock, quarter past and half past.

## Physical Education



This half term we will begin to link running and jumping. We will focus on practising and refining a range of running. We will continue to develop our running techniques to throw over long distances. PE will take place outside, please ensure your child has appropriate footwear.

## R.E



We will be revisiting the Christian Bible, reading some of the stories it contains, unpicking the message from God behind each of the story.

## Music



This half term we will be learning the song 'Come dance with me' to help us develop our skills of call-and-response, echo singing and playing, playing percussion and developing beat skills.

## PSHE



We will be identifying what it means to have a healthy balanced diet and we will discuss the importance of dental care. We will follow this by focussing on sun safety and why it is important. We will then discuss as a class the importance of sleep and hygiene and the impact they both have on staying healthy.

## Computing



We will be combining our Maths and Computing skills to look at using software sketchpad to represent data. Through using this we will be reinforcing our mouse control skills through dragging and dropping images, altering their size and location.

## Geography



We will be naming and locating the 7 continents and 5 oceans. We will be 'visiting' each of the continents, comparing the human and physical features and the weather associated with key areas of these continents. We will track our journey with our passport, creating our world map along the way.

## Science



This half term we will be looking at plants, identifying deciduous and evergreen trees and naming them. We will also be identifying and naming common garden plants. We will be looking at the structure of them. We will also be checking on the growth of the beetroot, carrots and sweet peas we grew earlier in the year, seeing how they have grown.
