Try some different ways of practising them.

1. Write your words in bubble writing.
2. Spell them out loud as you step down each step on the stairs!
3. Write them on post it notes around the house to practise them as you get ready in the morning.
4. Write them in chalk on the pavement.
5. Write them in the bubbles in the bath.
6. Write a crazy story using as many of the words as you can.
7. Use Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check.
8. Write it in the air.
9. Test your parents and check as they spell!
10. Cheerleader spellings.
11. Use magnetic letters.
