Below is a list of 10 words we will be learning in school this half term. 4. Write them in chalk on the pavement.
5. Write them in the bubbles in the bath.
6. Write a crazy story using as many of the words as you can.
7. Use Look, Say, Cover, Write, Check.
8. Write it in the air.
9. Test your parents and check as they spell!
10. Cheerleader spellings.
11. Use magnetic letters.
