Log in to MyMaths to find lots of maths activities linked to our learning in school. There are loads of activities to find in the section labelled 'Practice'.



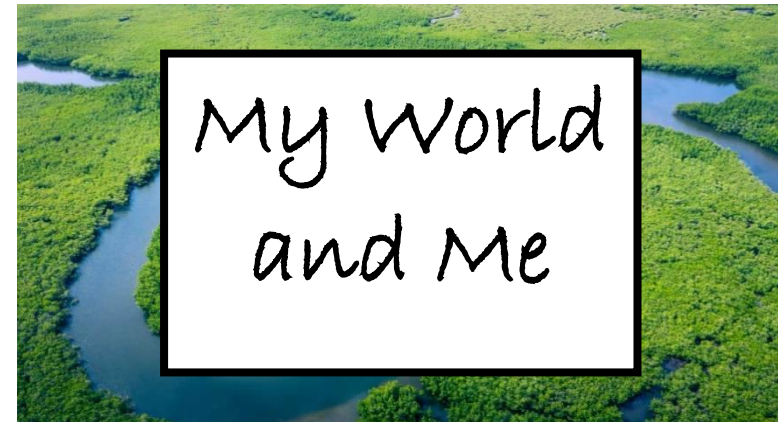
Spelling test

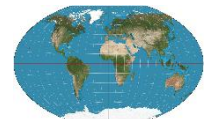
River model
